CFC Handbook excerpt:

NCSA, including CFC, is a not-for-profit organization. Volunteer opportunities are available year round to help support various activities and initiatives. All families are encouraged to volunteer in whatever capacity they are able. NYSWYSA requires all volunteers with direct contact with players to submit and complete a background check. This includes all coaches, team managers, and committee members.

Registration will begin in November of each year for the following spring travel season and in July of each year for the following fall travel season. Registration shall be online only. All players must be registered and have a current balance. Registration fees are determined during the Travel Committee's annual budget review process and, in general, are set to cover the costs associated with playing competitive soccer (e.g., insurance and league fees). Registration fees do not cover the following: uniforms and tournaments.
